down then untill Aug.

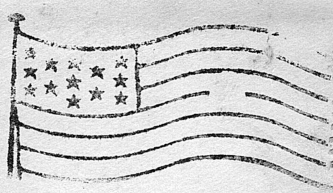
— 20 — if that will
