road.

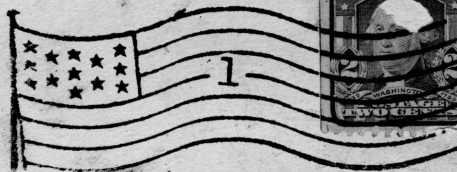
Right you are
