can hardly wait

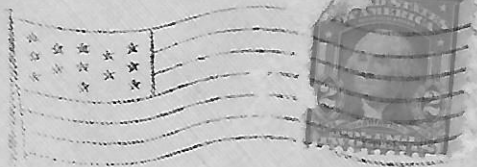
till you come home.
